## A MEMBER'S VOICE

I used to visit a kiosk near my office each morning to purchase a bagel and orange juice. During one such visit a brochure caught my eye. It described a nutrition-based method for boosting your memory. For some reason it grabbed my attention. After all, I could use some help with my memory. So, I picked up the brochure and walked toward my office—and left my bagel on the counter!

I realized this about the time that the guy behind the counter called out to me. I chuckled, went back and picked up my breakfast, and walked to the office to consider what had just occurred.

Many people today have memory problems. A few may have issues related to nutrition. Some may have medical conditions that cause their problems.

Others, like myself, have another type of problem—distractions! In this busy world, there are so many distractions that pull us away from the really important things. One section of the book *First Things First* by Stephen R. Covey is entitled: The Main Thing is to Keep the Main Thing the Main Thing. This is not a new principle—in fact, it is one that is based on Scripture.

*“There we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us.” - Hebrews 12:1*

It's apparent that the inspired Hebrew writer knew and understood the distractions that we would face in the 21st century. They aren't much different than those of the 1st century.
