A MEMBER'S VOICE

For nearly 11 years I have been driving the same old pickup truck. I have never owned a single vehicle near that long and certainly have never driven one 140,000 miles as I have this one. Drive a truck that long and it becomes very familiar to you. It seems so natural to sit in that truck and drive it.

This past Wednesday night, Patrick read from Romans 12:

"I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect."

Romans 12:1-2 (English Standard Version)

One of the things that feels most comfortable about my old truck is the fact that the seat fits me just right. The same—how should I phrase this—driver has been in that seat for its entire existence. So, the seat has become conformed to me. I haven't adjusted to the seat, it has adjusted to me.

Our daily lives should be conducted in the same manner. We should never be conformed to the world. Does that mean we are never to be in the world? Certainly not! It just means that we should not allow the world to change us. It's inevitable that we will be placed within the world. It would be nice if we could isolate ourselves from the world, but we can't. Not in the classroom. Not in the workplace.

So, as we live our lives, make sure that the one thing that is constant is our Christian behavior. Never, ever allow the world to change who and what you are!
